6. Supervision

The work of the expert will also be closely monitored by the International Organisation for Migration (IOM) during the duration of his/her assignment.

7. Duration and Location:

The Contract will have a duration of three (3) months and the diaspora can choose to work either on-site or remotely and the deployment can be any time between 1 October – 31 March 2025. If they work on-site, the location will be based on the institution where they will be placed. But this will also depend on the security situation and the availability of facilities.

8. Reporting Obligation and Deliverables

- Skill development: The main duty of the eligible Diaspora expert that will be used to evaluate
 his/her performance will be to ensure regular and consistent sharing of knowledge and skills
 as related to the assignment.
- Work plan: The immediate supervisor will create a work plan with the assignee in the first
 week of the assignment to outline clear and time-bound activities to achieve the outputs of
 the assignment. The supervisor of the hosting institution and IOM will receive this work plan.
 This work plan can be updated during the assignment to accommodate new developments
 or changes.
- Monthly Updates: The Diaspora expert will send monthly reports on their progress to the supervisor at the host institution and IOM.
- Departure interview: A departure interview will be done to collect feedback and suggestions for future projects by other specialists.
